## The Analytic Philosophy of Mathematical Epidemiology

**The Speaker:** Eduardo Massad is a Professor of Medical Informatics and Tropical Medicine from the School of Medicine, The University of São Paulo. His education background is unusually diversfied: M.D., B.Sc.(Physics), FIMA, Chartered Mathematician, Chartered Scientist, FRSM, among others. He is also the Head of the Department of Legal Medicine, University of Sao Paulo, and an Honorary Professor of Infectious Diseases, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. He was the Courage Fund Visiting Professor of Medicine, National University of Singapore; a Fellow of the Institute of Mathematics and Its Applications (FIMA) and a Fellow of The Royal Society of Medicine (FRSM). He is internationally acclaimed for his work in the field of infectious disease epidemiology, both in the mathematical modeling of infectious diseases and in the introduction of successful disease control programs in Brazil.
